All other craft must gain the approval of the Tira Committee

Life jackets must be worn as all times on the WAKA and in the WATER (BYO or these will be provided by Waka Owners.

HOE (paddles) are also provided by Waka Owners

ALL Rangatahi aged 12-17 years (inclusive) must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver 18 years and over. The ragatahi-caregiver ratio is 1:1. Caregivers need to take responsibility of their rangatahi at all times, both on and off the Awa.
