- Continue the implementation of Mouri Tūroa and restoration mahi along the manga iti and manga nui

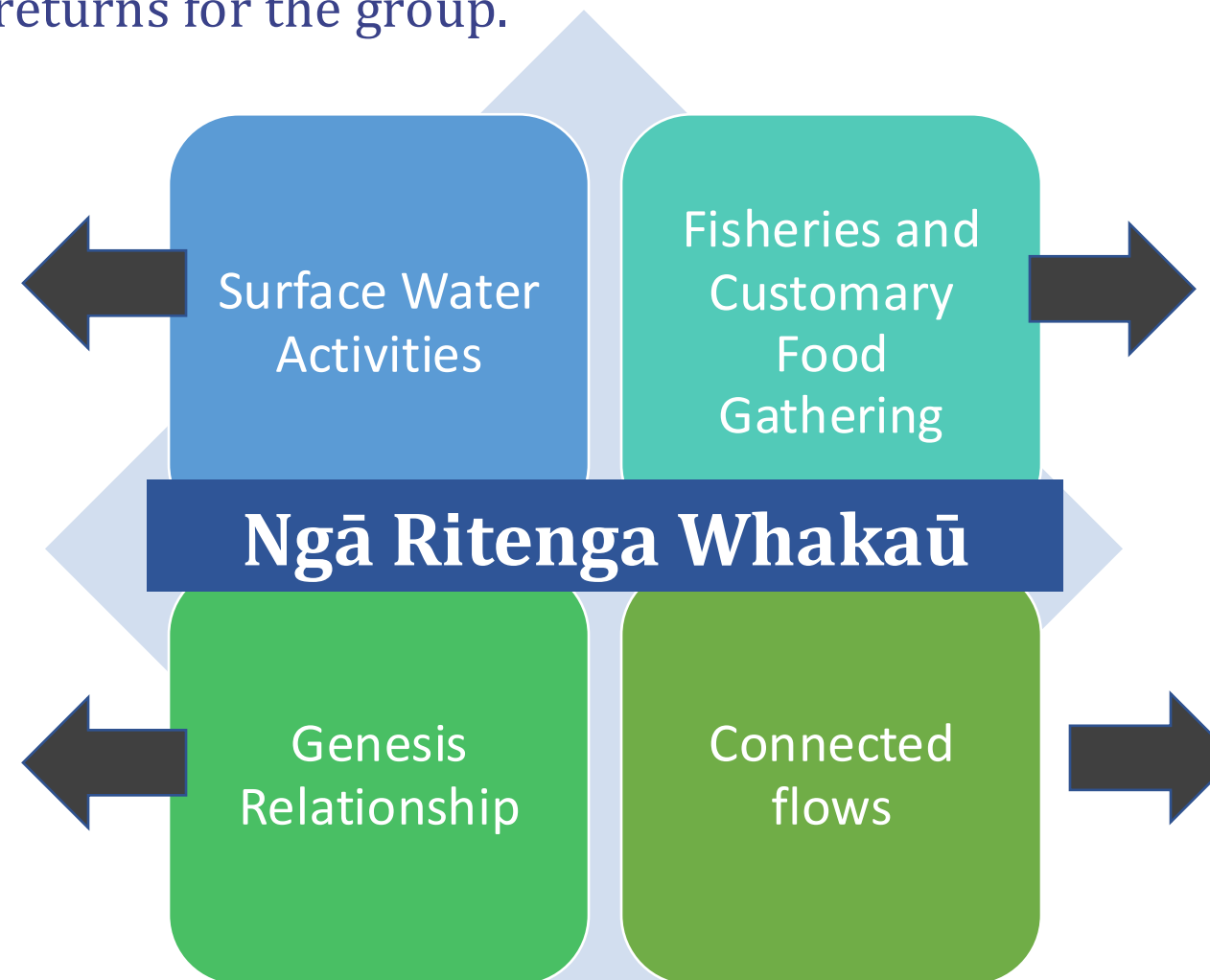
Ruruku Whakatupua - Te Mana o Te Iwi

- Support hapū to build capacity and capability required to achieve their aspirations for Mouri Ora, Mouri Awa, Mouri Tāngata.
- Establish Te Pākukururu an ongoing relationship with the Crown as described in Ruruku Whakatupua.
- With trust and confidence in each other based on Tupua te Kawa, Ngā Tāngata Tiaki o Whanganui shall support Te Whawhaki responsible to implement Te Rautaki o Te Whawhaki 2020 to 2040 and support Te Ngākinga and Whanganui Iwi Fisheries Limited tasked to generate ongoing sustainable economic returns for the group.

Complete hui to understand the iwi aspirations for effective management of surface water activities.

Establish the collaborative group to review how activities are carried out and consider how to improve and coordinate the management of activities

Reset the relationship agreements between Whanganui Iwi and Genesis raising the relationship to a governance level.



Continue to work alongside our traditional fishermen and support their aspirations for the management and protection of practices.

Work with entities responsible for fisheries management to contribute to the protection, management, and sustainable utilisations of fisheries and fish habitat.

Operationally contribute to the reconnection of flow and restoration of mouri on the ngā manga iti affected by the western diversion of the Tongariro Power Development scheme. Reconnecting flows on the Taurewa, Okupata and Tawhitikuri whilst guided by people at place.
